

Hetton Lyons Country Park

Hetton Lyons Country Park is picturesque park located to the east of Hetton-le-Hole.

It features a sporting lake, fishing lakes, football pitches, orienteering course, play park and is also part of the national cycling network, with dedicated cycle tracks and trails. The park is also a part of the W2W cycling trail.

The parkland venue boasts a large grassed event space, a closed perimeter road used for running and cycling events, and a watersports lake suitable for swimming events. The venue has been used for British Cycling events, including the National Cyclocross Championships, community sports and activity festivals, triathlon training and equestrian sports.

Sunderland City Council delivers and hosts many large scale events. We understand requirements regarding costs, infrastructure and licensing, and we are very keen to help organisers make the most of the fantastic opportunities the city has to offer.
