## **Mowbray Park, next to Sunderland Museum, Library and Winter Gardens, is located in the heart of the city.**

Home to a wide array of outdoor events and featuring a terrace, lake and play park, this beautiful Victorian park offers versatile grassed event spaces and a bandstand. The site is significant in size and can be scalable to suit the occasion.

The park has been used to host sporting festivals, fun runs, music festivals, community events, open air movies, theatrical performances and the annual Remembrance Sunday Commemoration.

With a city centre location, Mowbray Park is close to Sunderland's bars, restaurants and shops and offers excellent transport links, with Sunderland Central Station Park Lane Interchange both just a few minutes' walk away. There are also several thousand on-street and multi-storey car parking places within the city centre.
