Princess Anne Park is next to Washington Leisure Centre and is suitable for sport events, public performances and festivals.

The park offers event spaces including lake, hillsides and flat areas. The site is significant in size and events can be scalable to suit the occasion. The spaces within the park have been used for everything from community sports festivals to charity runs and community events.

Five minutes' walk from the main bus interchange at The Galleries, there are excellent connections with Sunderland, Durham and Newcastle upon Tyne, and many other towns in the region. Major roads run nearby and all connect with the A1 or A19 providing easy routes for traffic.

In addition to the existing excellent transport links, local public transport providers are also very willing to discuss alternative arrangements if required.
