

# Rectory Field

Off Dairy Lane, Houghton-le-Spring DH4 5BL

**To the west of Rectory Park (one of the oldest gardens in the UK) is Rectory Field, a grassed open space with hard standing access directly from Dairy Lane.**

Home to a wide array of outdoor events, the field is used best known for hosting the annual Houghton Feast Funfair.

The defined area and adaptable spaces makes Rectory Field an ideal venue for community events, exhibitions and funfairs of all types.

There is excellent access to the park via main transport links and the site is minutes from the A690 which provides easy routes to both the A19 and A1. In addition to the current transport arrangements local public transport providers are also very willing to discuss alternative arrangements if required.
