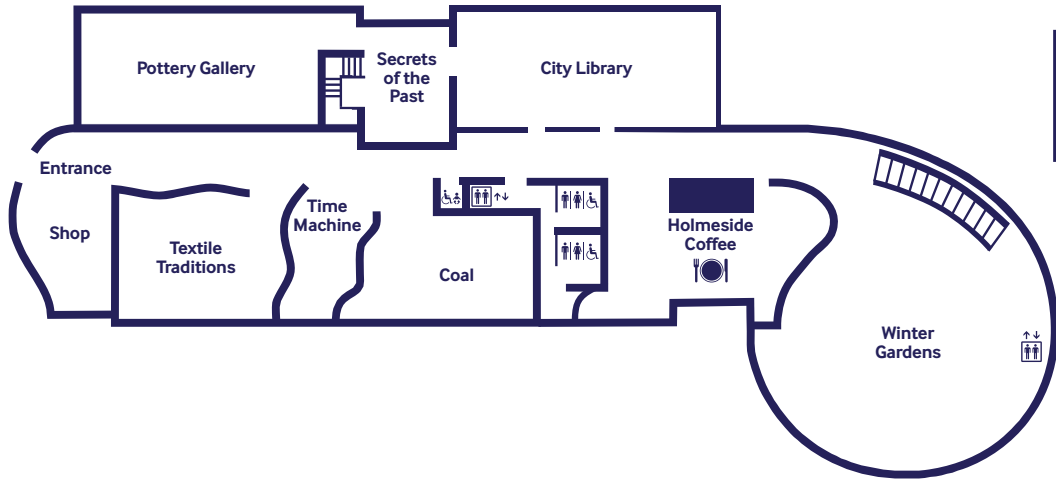

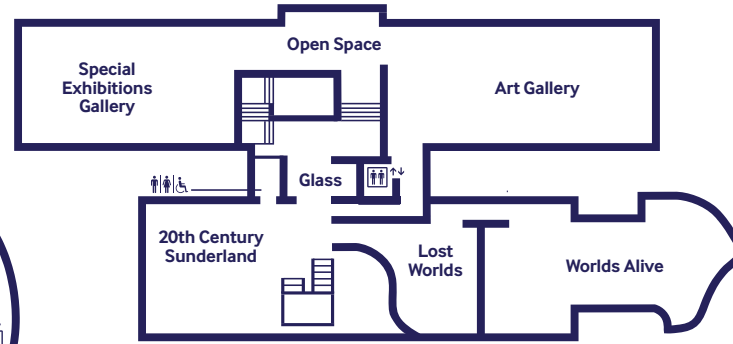


# Venue plan
