Frequently Asked Questions **Parking and travel**



1. Where is the Festival of Light?

The Festival of Light has moved to a new location and will take place in Mowbray Park, Sunderland city centre SR1 1PP.

2. What is the easiest way to travel to the Festival of Light?

Sunderland city centre has excellent transport links and a number of car parks.

Sunderland Train Station is a National Rail and Tyne and Wear Metro Station and is a 5-minute walk to the event.

Park Lane Bus Interchange and Tyne and Wear Metro Station is an approximate 10-minute walk to the event.

3. Where can I park in the city centre?

There are a number of car parks in the city centre, all within walking distance of the event and other Christmas in Sunderland activities. Popular car parks include:
